As the following policy terms set forth, we are very careful to maintain the security and confidentiality of our clients' personal information

What Information do we collect?

To conduct regular business, we may collect nonpublic personal information from sources such as:

- Information reported by you on applications or other forms you provide to us;
- Information about your transactions with us, our affiliates, or others; and
- Information we receive as part of a consumer report and from public records.

How do we use such information?

At times, we may disclose nonpublic personal information to affiliated or nonaffiliated third parties, however, we share such information only with such parties that are also providing services to our clients. Therefore, the parties with whom information is shared are those parties with whom our clients have relationships and such sharing of information is done to provide the services our clients desire. In doing so, we may

share any of the nonpublic personal information that we collect as described above with the following types of affiliated or nonaffiliated third parties:

- Legal and accounting entities,
- Financial service entities, and
- Insurance entities.

Otherwise, we do not share or disclose any nonpublic personal information about our current or former clients, except as required by law. All information will remain confidential.

What safeguards do we use?

GSG ADVISORS internally safeguards your nonpublic personal information by restricting access to only those employees who provide products or services to you or those who need access to your information to service your account. In addition, we will maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards that meet applicable standards to guard your nonpublic personal information.

Changes to Our Privacy Policy
